1 Pair of 3¼mm (UK10 - USA3) Knitting Needles.								
<b>TENSION</b>								
22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm, (4in) over pattern on 4mm needles or the size required to give correct tension.								
IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

### COAT

Using 3¼mm needles cast on 38 [78:94] sts.

1st Row. S1, knit to end.

Disregarding slipped st, this row will now be referred to as g-st (garter stitch - every row knit).

Work 3 more rows in g-st, slipping first st on each row.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

1st Row. S1, k4, \* k4, p4, rep from \* to last 9 sts, k9.

2nd Row. S1, k4, \* p4, k4, rep from \* to last 9 sts, p4, k5.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows once more.

5th Row. As 2nd row.

6th Row. As 1st row.

Rep 5th and 6th rows once more. These 8 rows form patt and g-st borders.

Work 4 [8:12] rows straight.

Keeping continuity of patt and g-st borders (throughout) and working inc sts inside g-st border, work 27 [31:73] rows

inc 1 st at each end on next and every foll 2nd [2nd:4th] row. 66 [110:132] sts.

Work straight until coat measures 17 [34:44]cm, (6½ [13½:17¼]in) from beg, ending with a rs row.

Divide for Leg Openings

Next Row. Patt 13 [18:21], k1, turn.

Next Row. K1, patt 13 [18:21].

Working on these 14 [19:22] sts only, work a further 8 [13:15]cm, (3 [5¼:6]in), ending with a ws row.

Break off yarn and leave these sts on a stitch holder.

With ws facing, rejoin yarn to next 38 [72:88] sts and proceed as follows:-

Next Row. K1, patt to last st, k1.

Rep last row for 8 [13:15]cm, (3 [5¼:6]in), ending with a ws row.

Break off yarn and leave these 38 [72:88] sts on a stitch holder.

With ws facing, rejoin yarn to rem 14 [19:22] sts and proceed as follows:-  
Next Row. K1, patt to end.

Next Row. Patt to last st, k1.

Work 8 [13:15]cm, (3 [5¼:6]in), on these sts, ending with a ws row.

Do not break off yarn.

With rs facing, work in patt as set across all 66 [110:132] sts for approximately 5 [8:9]cm, (2 [3:3½]in), ending with 4th or 8th row of patt.

Next Row. K8 [10:21], k2tog. (k2, k2tog) 12 [22:22] times, k8 [10:21].

53 [87:109] sts.

1st Row. S1, k5, \* p1, k1, rep from \* to last 5 sts, k5.

2nd Row. S1, k4, \* p1, k1, rep from \* to last 6 sts, p1, k5.

Rep last 2 rows for 5 [6:8]cm, (2 [2½:3]in), ending with 2nd row.

Work 3 rows in g-st.

Cast off knitways.

### TO MAKE UP

Beg 8 [9:10]cm, (3 [3½:4]in) from cast off edge, join an 8 [9:10]cm, (3 [3½:4]in) seam along under side.

### BLANKETS

Using 3¼mm needles cast on 120 [168:216] sts.

Knit 10 rows, slipping first st on every row.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

1st Row. S1, k5, \* p4, k4, rep from \* to last 10 sts, p4, k6.

2nd Row. S1, k5, \* k4, p4, rep from \* to last 10 sts, k10.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows once more.

5th Row. As 2nd row.

6th Row. As 1st row.

Rep 5th and 6th rows once more.

These 8 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approximately 52 [74:97]cm, (20½ [29¼:38]in), ending with 4th or 8th row of patt.

Change to 3¼mm needles.

Knit 10 rows, slipping first st on every row. Cast off.

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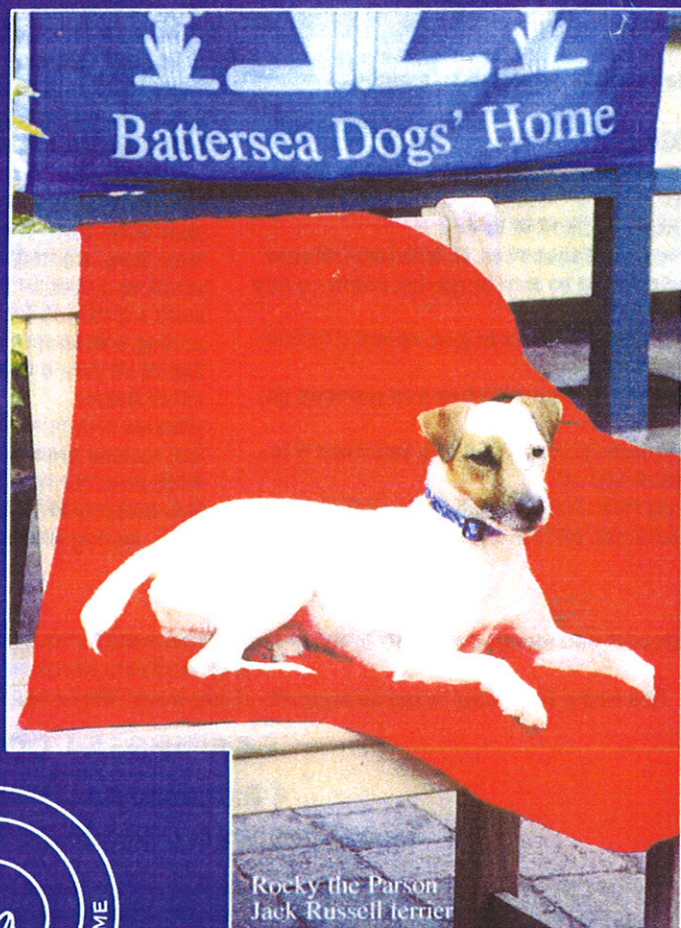
